

**TECHNICAL DATASHEET  
PRIMORIORI LEMON**

VARIETY: Early Fine Lemon.

DESCRIPTION:

Spanish variety. It probably comes from a common lemon seed from the Murcia meadow. The tree is very vigorous and very large in size. It has a certain tendency to emit shoots with thorns. It blooms little, being the flowering more grouped than the Verna lemon and generally it begins a little later. Pollen viability is medium. The fruit is marketed under the name of Primofiori. This is medium in size and spherical-oval in shape. Collarless at the base, short, pointed mamelon. It has more seeds and finer skin than the Verna variety. Collection in first and second season (October-February). Great quality for fresh consumption and for the industry.

FRUIT CHARACTERISTICS:

Weight (g): 110 - 130

Diameter (mm): 57 - 62

Form: Oval, no neck in peduncular region and small apical mamelon.

Cortex (mm): 4 – 6 mm.

Colour: Yellow

% Juice: 35 – 40 %

Seeds: 6 - 15. To Higher temperaturas in flowering it has more seeds.

Harvest: 20th septiembre – 15th abril. Harvesting begins when it is greenish, when it reaches the sufficient size and percentage of juice.
